### CONNECT

- Recall the Thomas Jefferson 'yes' face story: who has been a 'yes' face consistently in your life? What makes for a 'yes' face?
- You and Your Blind spots: "an area or subject about which one is uninformed or unappreciative." When you hear the phrase 'blind spot detection' what comes to mind?

### ENGAGE

#### ***Read 2 Timothy 2:20-26***

Paul speaks to Timothy about 3 areas where maturity matters.

- a. righteous character matters: 2 Timothy 2:20-22
  - b. productive conduct matters: 2 Timothy 2:23-24
  - c. influential contribution matters: 2 Timothy 2:24-26
- In what area do you see a need to growth and why?
  - Where do you see clear evidence of growth? Be encouraged!

#### ***Blind spot Detectors: Read again 2 Timothy 2:22***

- What kind of person do you look for to trust your life to (blind spots included)?
- Who are you walking with that increase your 'wisdom resources'? *Cross-reference Proverbs 13:20*

### APPLY

- What will it take for you to become a trusted blind spot detector?
- What blind spot is God pointing out to you? What next steps do you need to take?
