- *"Jesus entered Jericho and was passing through." Luke 19:1*
- *"He wanted to see who Jesus was, but being a short man he could not, because of the crowd. So he ran ahead and climbed a sycamore-fig tree to see him, since Jesus was coming that way." Luke 19:3,4*
- *"When Jesus reached the spot, he looked up and said to him, "Zacchaeus, come down immediately. I must stay at your house today."
So he came down at once and welcomed him gladly." Luke 19:5,6*
- *"All the people saw this and began to mutter, 'He has gone to be the guest of a sinner.'" Luke 19:7*
- *"But Zacchaeus stood up..." Luke 19:8a*
- *"But Zacchaeus stood up and said to the Lord, 'Look, Lord! Here and now I give half of my possessions to the poor, and if I have cheated anybody out of anything, I will pay back four times the amount.'" Luke 19:8*
- *"Jesus said to him, 'Today salvation has come to this house, because this man, too, is a son of Abraham.'" Luke 19:9*
- *"and if you spend yourselves in behalf of the hungry and satisfy the needs of the oppressed, then your light will rise in the darkness, and your night will become like the noonday. The Lord will guide you always; he will satisfy your needs in a sun-scorched land and will strengthen your frame. You will be like a well-watered garden, like a spring whose waters never fail." Isaiah 58:10,11*
