Message Title: This is What Matters Deeply to God

Scripture Source: Micah 6:8

Sunday, August 2, 2020

CONNECT:

What social issue(s) make you think and feel deeply...wondering, 'what can I do?'

ENGAGE:

Micah 6:8 - Read this verse carefully - what stands out to you? What stirs you...and why?

1. God feels deeply. If you read through Micah, the emotional pain of God is startling. Micah 5:19 as an example.
2. Do you realize...do I, that our lives affect God emotionally? What do you think of that reality?
3. So, this is what matters deeply to God: act justly, love mercy, walk humbly with your God.
Please note: these words aren't suggestions, they are expectations from the mind and heart of God.
4. Act justly: treat others with respect, integrity and honesty. Don't exploit others in any way for personal gain or pleasure. What does pursuing just living look like to you?
5. Love mercy: a steadfast resolve to care for and serve others with compassion and wisdom. Anyone in your world that needs you to live out his verse in ways that touch them? What could that look like?
6. Walk humbly with God: what does that actually mean? What behaviours and attitudes does God look for in those who profess to be his followers?

RESPONSE:

Which behaviours/attitudes requires attention from you most purposefully currently?

What truth or insight made you stop and think from the message and Scriptures? Be as specific as possible!
