**CONNECT:**

Who do you personally know that is really 'comfortable in their own skin'?

What does that phrase mean to you? Consider this definition: "relaxed and confident in one's manner of presenting oneself and interacting with others; conveying the impression that one has a clear, satisfying understanding of one's abilities and situation."

**ENGAGE:**

Read carefully the story...and back story of David and Goliath in 1 Samuel 17:26-50

1. What stands out to you about how David responds to Saul's 'dressing of him' in vs.38-39?

2. Here are some lessons and insights for us today:

a. Cultivate your relationship with Jesus day to day...how do you do that?

b. Learn from others who are living out Ephesians 2:10. Learn from them; don't mimic them.

c. Dress yourself...don't allow others to 'dress you' with their expectations and demands.

Read through the wardrobe of Colossians 3:12-14

d. Be thankful for opportunities to serve others in Jesus' name.

**RESPONSE:**

So, which lesson or insight do you need to pay attention to today...and act upon?
